Candidates with a base certificate in SWD P-12 are eligible to be recommended for the extension title for "special class teacher" at grade level P-12 once they have successfully completed 12 semester hours of study or its equivalent in one or more of the following:

- Earth Science
- Biology
- Chemistry
- Physics
- Social Studies
- Mathematics
- English
- Spanish
- French

For Social Studies, the candidate shall complete the 18 semester hours through a combination of study in United States history, world history and geography. (Note: History is the only area from list above that SUNY Cobleskill students will likely have 18 credits in and therefore be eligible for extension.)

B. To attract qualified students to both institutions who wish to pursue a master's degree leading to NYS Teacher's Certification, Students with Disabilities Grade P-12.
